- **Note:** 1. The next academic Session 2021-22 will start w.e.f. 01.08.2021 in UG courses and 01.09.2021 in PG courses.
 - 2. The classes of the Odd Semester (Fresh) will commence from 06.10.2020 in UG courses and 21.11.2020 in PG courses in the online/offline mode as per situation subject to directions from the State Government, if any.
 - 3. If the number of teaching days falls less than 180 days (90 days in each semester) in the academic session 2020-21 due to some unforeseen reasons, it would be the responsibility of each Department/Institute/College to make good the loss by arranging extra classes.
 - 4. The State Universities are authorized to make minor changes/adjustment according to their local condition at their own level, keeping in view the condition of minimum 90 teaching days in each semester.
